An Update on Our Giving for Ukraine

What an impact our district is having in the Ukraine! We have received \$154,490 In donations from clubs and individuals in our district. We have transferred \$36,500 In cash to Rotary District 2241 for them to use as needed. Last month we shared the report from Buckhead Rotarian Radu Zernoveanu about the aid we have provided to that district. In addition to funds forwarded, we have used your donations to purchase and send \$121,975 of specifically requested medical equipment - orthopedic surgical drill and saw sets, negative pressure wound care systems, infant incubators. Stone Mountain Rotarian Chris Brand has coordinated volunteers from the Rotary Clubs of Buckhead, Decatur, Midtown Atlanta, Roswell, Stone Mountain, and Tucker in sorting and packing items for shipment at FODAC.
